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【*Elementary Japanese 1 Part 6*】

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This is the **final** course of the three-part Elementary Japanese Language and Culture 1 series. Students build on skills developed during the past courses they took and keep practicing, focusing on interacting with others. More sentence patterns will be introduced to expand the repertoire of expressions. Part 6 also introduces about 50 more everyday Kanji words.

It is strongly recommended that you schedule time (a few hours a week) to engage in out-of-class practice.

At the end of the course, successful learners will:

- Be able to interact with foreign visitors
- Be able to talk about staying healthy and give advice
- Be able to talk about celebrations and gift-giving

PREREQUISITES: You have the knowledge and minimum skills in:

- Hiragana & Katakana and about 150 basic Kanji words
- Using some plain forms of verbs & adjectives
- Talking on various everyday topics
